



COACH OF THE WEEK — Walter Emmot, head Independence High school football coach, has been honored by the Topeka Capital as "Coach of the Week" in Kansas high school football. Emmot's Independence Bulldogs defeated Coffeyville, 13-6, here Friday to win the SEK league championship and finished the season undefeated and untied. It is the first perfect season's record for IHS since 1932. In four seasons as head Bulldog coach, Emmot has guided the IHS gridders to three victories over their arch county rivals, Coffeyville.
